

## Adult Speaker's Vocabulary Arranged Alphabetically

**REFERENCE**: Balandin, S. & Iacono, T. (1999). Crews, wusses and whoppas: Core and Fringe Vocabularies if Australian meal-break conversations in the workplace. Augmentative and Alternative Communication, 15, 95-109

Conversational samples were collected from 34 non-disabled subjects across four work sites. There was a small stable core vocabulary of 347 words which accounted for 78% of the conversational sample in the study by Balandin and Iacono.
