

Older Adults' Vocabulary **Arranged Alphabetically**

Stuart, Beukelman and King identified the vocabulary use patterns of 64-74 year old and 75-85 year old adults. The 250 more common words were 78% of the total words. This list represents the 179 most commonly used words by at least 8 out 10 people in each age group. This list of 179 words represents 72% of the total words used.
