Stuart, Beukelman and King identified the vocabulary use patterns of $64-74$ year old and 75 85 year old adults. The 250 more common words were $78 \%$ of the total words. This list represents the 179 most commonly used words by at least 8 out 10 people in each age group. This list of 179 words represents $72 \%$ of the total words used.
