

# LR7-20+ RUGGED - TRANSFER VOCABULARY FILES USING A USB-C STICK



#### **Important Functions**

Below are the main Functions buttons on the LR7 Rugged devices:

**Menu** allows you to determine which vocabulary file will be used, which augmentative options are enabled, how and when to speak messages, and how a wide variety of other options are configured.

**Home** navigates out of Chat software to the Home screen of the Android software.

**Back** navigates to previous page or to previous Menu. Pressing and holding the Back button also reveals the Chat software menu.

You may backup to and from a USB stick if your device is **running v2.15 software and above**. This is true for all LR7-20/30 RUGGED devices.

You will require a Saltillo USB/USB-C multi-stick. This is provided when you purchase the LR7 device.





#### **Transferring Vocabulary Files**

 Plug in the USB stick into the USB-C port on your device.

**Note:** If the device's file manager opens, use the device's Back button to close it.

- Change the default write disk to External USB Storage (a pop-up message will prompt you to change this).
- 3. On the Chat Software, select Menu > Library
- 4. Select Menu > Import/Export

A different file management screen may open. Depending on your device, select or navigate to the External USB storage.. 5. Select the desired folder you wish to save your backup to by pressing on SELECT "X" at the bottom centre of the screen. \*\*This example shows the LOST DIR folder being used,



A window will list the customized files under **Device** on the left. Any files already on the USB drive are listed under **Backup Folder** on the right.



### To transfer files from your device to the USB drive:

- Select each file on the device that you want to copy to the USB drive.
- Select To Backup, which is now highlighted. The files will be copied to the USB drive. When the files finish copying, they will be listed under Backup Folder.

## To transfer files from the USB drive to your device:

- Select each file on the USB stick that you want to copy to the device.
- 2. Select **To Device**, which is now highlighted. The file(s) will be copied to the device. When the files finish copying, they will be listed under **Device**.



3. When you finish transferring files, disconnect the USB stick from your device and store it in a safe location and/or copy the files from the USB drive to a computer for safe keeping.

#### **USB Transfer – Known Errors**

If you are importing a file that contains an imported image, and that same imported image also exists on two files on the device, the transfer will error out.
