## Liberator Yoghurt pot bird feeder

## Equipment

- Suet or Lard (room temperature) cut into cubes
- Bird Seed
- Empty cleaned out yoghurt pot
- Lolly stick
- String
- Mixing bowl
- Scissors


## Vocabulary

Core - awesome, do, eat, feel, get, good, ha-ha, help, I, in, it, like, look, make, me, mine, more, not, off, on, pour, put, take, that, want, you

Fringe -bird, fat, pot, seeds, stick, string

## What to do

1. Make a small hole in the bottom of the yogurt pot, then thread a length of string through the hole and tie the end near the mouth of the pot around a lolly stick.
2. Place the fat in the mixing bowl and add around double the amount of bird seed.
3. Squish the seeds and fat together with your hands. If the mixture feels a little runny add more seeds until it holds together well.
4. Press the mixture into the yoghurt pot pressing it down firmly until the pot is full.
5. Once set (pop it in the fridge or freezer), gently remove the yoghurt pot, then tie a loop in the end of the string.
6. Hang your feeder outside and wait for the birds to visit!

NB - This activity can be adapted dependent on the ability of the individual you are supporting. If the person needs a high-level of physical support this can be provided. If the individual will be unable to physically manipulate the items they can direct others.
