

Disability Pride Biscuits!

Equipment

- Biscuits (homemade or bought)
- Fondant icing (white, green, red, blue, gold, black)
- Rolling pin

Vocabulary

Core – again, different, do, feel, get, good, bad, happy, help, put, stop, take, like, look, want, that, more, open, close, ready, go, on, off, it, not

Fringe – roll, icing, red, white, green, blue, gold, black

What to do

- 1. Place a biscuit on a plate
- 2. Roll out some black fondant icing and place it on top of your biscuit
- 3. Roll out thin tube shapes with the different colours of icing
- 4. Place all the colours next to each other and mould into a lightening shape
- 5. Place the lightening shape onto your biscuit
- 6. Repeat with the rest of your biscuits and then tuck in!

NB – This activity can be further adapted dependent on the ability of the individual you are supporting. If the person needs a high-level of physical support this can be provided. If the individual will be unable to physically manipulate the items, they can direct others.

Sentence Ideas

1WL go all done, like, feel, look, help, different

2WL – this one, I do, put on, different one, look good

3WL – the red one, don't like it, it tastes good, it feels sticky, wash it off

Language Functions

Requesting – more, want more, let's get more

Directing – do, let's do it, what's next?

Commenting – good, that's good,

Refusing – stop, let's stop now

Interjecting – cool, it's so cool
