What to do

This simple activity is a great way to observe nature from the comfort of your home!

Access the webcams on a laptop, tablet, phone or smart TV through either the Woodland Trust Website or Searching for 'Loch Arkaig Osprey Camera' on YouTube.

Settle down and watch the Ospreys in action! Talk about what is happening on the camera. As the birds come and go you can talk about what they are doing. Whilst they are on the nest talk about what you can see happening around them.

Sentence Ideas

1WL - look, eat, go, come,

2WL - it come, get fish, it eat, look go, what do? like it, eat more, go again

3WL - look it come, it get fish, bird get on, take it out, bird eat fish,

Language Functions

Requesting – do, I do, I do it

Directing – on, turn on, turn it on

Commenting – eat! bird eat! Look bird eat!

Refusing – don't want, don't want look

Interjecting – awesome!

Generalisation You can use similar vocabulary words in any other activity where you are observing nature – the park, the zoo, the duck pond and so much more!
